Carol Johnson has more than 20 years of experience at the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). She has been a policy analyst in OMB's Office of Federal Financial Management (OFFM) since the fall of 2016 and is responsible for Federal financial reporting.

In addition to her more recent experience with financial reporting and accounting, Carol has considerable experience with budgetary accounting and the Federal Government's budget process.
