¹ Amendments (P.L. 96-533) to the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 changed the title of the USAID Auditor General to Inspector General, effective December 30, 1980. The enactment of the International Security and Development Cooperation Act on December 31, 1981, brought USAID's OIG under the IG Act of 1978 and confirmed the incumbent to be the IG.

² Acting Inspector General designation expired after 240 days. Ms. Donegan re-assumed her position as Deputy Inspector General.

³ Was appointed Acting Inspector General of the Corp. for National and Community Service and retained the duties of Inspector General of ACTION until the merger on April 4, 1994.

⁴ Appointment via Inspector General Act of 1978, dated October 12, 1978.

⁵ OIG Administratively Re-established by Secretary's Memorandum 1915, dated March 23, 1977.

Mr. Sherick, was sworn in as the first Inspector General on May 20, 1983. The official anniversary date, however, for the IG, DOD, has been established as April 20, 1981.

¹¹ Mr. Vander Schaaf was also the de facto Acting IG from June 1985 to June 3, 1986, while Mr. Sherick was on extended sick leave. Mr. Vander Schaaf did not use the title of Acting Inspector General and remained Deputy Inspector General.

²⁸ The Foreign Relations Authorization Act for fiscal years 1986 and 1987 (PL 99-93) amended the IG Act to include the Department of State and the Foreign Service. The Omnibus Diplomatic Security and Antiterrorism Act of 1986, (PL 99-399) required the establishment of an independent OIG at State by October 1, 1986. The OIG was established on August 27, 1986.

²⁹ In 1957, the title Chief Inspector was changed to Inspector General.

³⁰ The functions, personnel, assets, and liabilities of the Federal Emergency Management Agency were transferred to the Department of Homeland Security on March 1, 2003, pursuant to P.L. 107-296.

³¹ The Deputy Inspector General assumes the position of Acting Inspector General in the event of the death, disability, absence or removal of the Inspector General unless the President designates another officer of the Government to perform the duties of the position.
