The purpose of this letter is to comply with Section 7 (9) of Public Law 110-409 [H.R. 928] of the Inspector General Reform Act of 2008, with an annual report to Congress and the President by December 31, 2009.


The IG Reform Act of 2008 incorporated changes that required the Integrity Committee (IC), in conjunction requiring the Council Chairperson, to address transparency and reporting issues for the IC. As part of the transparency and reporting requirements, the IC submits the following information for fiscal year 2009.

- The number of allegations received. (43)
- The number of allegations referred to other agencies, including the number of allegations referred for criminal investigation. (5)
- The number of allegations referred to the Chairperson of the Integrity Committee for investigation. (2)
- The number of allegations closed without referral. (16)
- The number of allegations closed but referred to the IG. (20)
- The opening and closing dates for each allegation. (see chart)
- In the case of allegations referred to the Chairperson of the Integrity Committee, a summary of the status of the investigation of the allegations and, in the case of an investigation completed during the proceeding fiscal year, a summary of the findings of the investigation. (see enclosure)
- Other matters that the Council considers appropriate. (none)

Summary of allegations referred to the Chairperson of the Integrity Committee (IC):

IC 606: An anonymous complaint was received on January 27, 2009, alleging a hostile work environment created by inappropriate behavior on the part of the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) Inspector General (IG) and the Deputy IG. The IC inquiry was not an investigation, rather, a request for assistance to obtain additional information from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Office of Inspector General (OIG), so that the IC could determine the correct course of action. Based on results of interviews provided by DHS OIG, the IC determined that the complaint lacked factual basis and directed case closure.

IC 611: An on-going administrative investigation involving the Inspector General for the Community Futures Commission.
