Atticus has had the opportunity to serve as General Counsel of two independent federal agencies established to provide support to the Inspector General (IG) community. Since 2015, Atticus has served as the General Counsel of the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency (CIGIE). Prior to joining CIGIE, from 2012 to 2015, Atticus served as General Counsel of the Recovery Accountability and Transparency Board (Recovery Board). He also served as Assistant General Counsel at the Recovery Board from 2010 to 2012.

While at the Recovery Board, Atticus provided legal support for all aspects of Recovery Board operations, including its Recovery Operations Center (ROC). Support of the ROC included advice and counsel to Recovery Board leadership in the acquisition and implementation of data sets and data analytics tools.
