Beth A. Hoffman León serves as the Director of the CIGIE Training Institute's, Audit, Inspection and Evaluation Academy. In her role, she manages the development, implementation, and administration of learning and professional development efforts for nearly 7,000 audit, and inspection and evaluation professionals across CIGIE's 74member organizations. She works collaboratively with internal and external stakeholders to support overall CIGIE operations and meet CIGIE's mandated mission of "increasing the professionalism and effectiveness of personnel by developing policies, standards, and approaches to aid in the establishment of a well-trained and highly skilled workforce in the offices of the Inspectors General." She is helping to facilitate and lead CIGIE's move to a "performance support" instructional methodology whereby member organizations' staff can access learning when and where they need it through a web-based "Navigator" platform. Prior to CIGIE, she worked for the U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO) auditing a wide range of federal government programs. She then served in GAO's Learning Center as the Director of Adjunct Faculty and Strategic Learning Programs where she coordinated, designed, and delivered auditor learning programs as well as recruited, trained, and coordinated the activities of some 300 GAO Adjunct Faculty members. She received her Master's Degree in Public and International Affairs, and Bachelors' Degrees in Political Science and History from the University of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
